

RESPECT YOUR CLOTHES

HOW TO REMOVE LINT FROM YOUR CLOTHING

Removing lint from your clothing can freshen up your garment without the need of washing it which helps the environment. It also removes dirt from the surface of the garment which can keep your fabrics looking fresher for longer as the need for washing is less.

THINGS YOU WILL NEED

- A lint roller
- A soft bristled clothes brush
- Adhesive tape
- A rubber glove

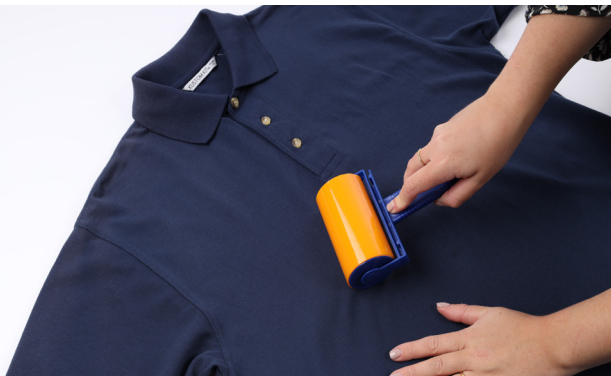
METHOD

OPTION 1. USING A LINT ROLLER

Sticky lint rollers have layers of disposable sticky sheets, but they're thrown away after use. However, you can buy environmental friendly lint rollers which are reusable, such as the one we have used in the below image which you rinse after use to remain sticky.

Position the garment up in a well-lit area.

Gently smooth the lint roller over the garment, until all the lint is removed.



OPTION 2. USING A SOFT BRISTLED CLOTHES BRUSH

Soft bristle brushes help to remove dirt from within the fabric, as well as from the surface.

This keeps the fabric clean and prevents damage from dust and dirt, prolonging the look of your garment.

Position the garment up in a well-lit area and brush it with the line of the fabric and not against it.



OPTION 4. USING A RUBBER GLOVE

This method is useful for removing stubborn pet hairs from fabrics.

Simply put the rubber glove on and smooth your hand over the garment, following the line of the fabric.

Any hairs should stick to the glove and then can be gathered and discarded.
